



# Global Ethics Training In El Salvador

## 2019 Bonner Scholar Delegation

Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019

### Overview

This tour is designed to introduce Bonner scholars to political, economic and ethical issues in global engagement and service learning. Using the medium of a collaborative work projects and home stays, Bonner scholars will have opportunities to compare and contrast cultures, develop a deeper appreciation of issues of inequality and economic justice, and explore how these learnings impact their thinking and trajectories as North Americans. This experience will include pre-departure work and orientation, presentations by Central Americans and daily directed reflections.

### Highlights

- Historic and cultural orientation with visits to the Archbishop Oscar Romero sites.
- Five days of collaborative work in grassroots projects in Santa Marta, El Salvador.
- Seven nights of home stay in a Salvadoran village
- A day of exploring the colonial town of Suchitoto
- Great food and conversation with CoCoDA staff, Salvadorans and your fellow scholars.

A full itinerary is on back.

### Cost

\$1,200 per person plus airfare. Airfare is usually about \$650.

This fee covers all in country expenses other than snacks and souvenirs as well as providing the community with \$200 of project support.

### Requirements

A current passport and an insatiable curiosity. (Spanish is helpful, but not required)
